	<p>Term 3 ELECTRICITY Construct and draw series circuits using circuit symbols. Look at complete and incomplete circuits and explore reasons why a circuit may be incomplete. Explore variations within circuits and the effects of having fewer or more components. Plan and carry out an enquiry voltage experiment.</p>		<p>Term 4 LIGHT Name and identify simple parts of the human eye and their function in relation to being able to see objects. Identify those light travels in straight lines, but that it can change direction if it reflects from an object. Use opaque objects to produce shadows with different shapes. Undertake a fair test to explore whether the distance from a light source affects the size of the shadow.</p>
