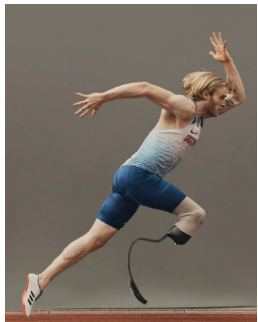


Everyone belongs...

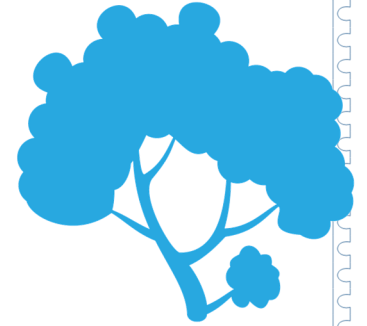

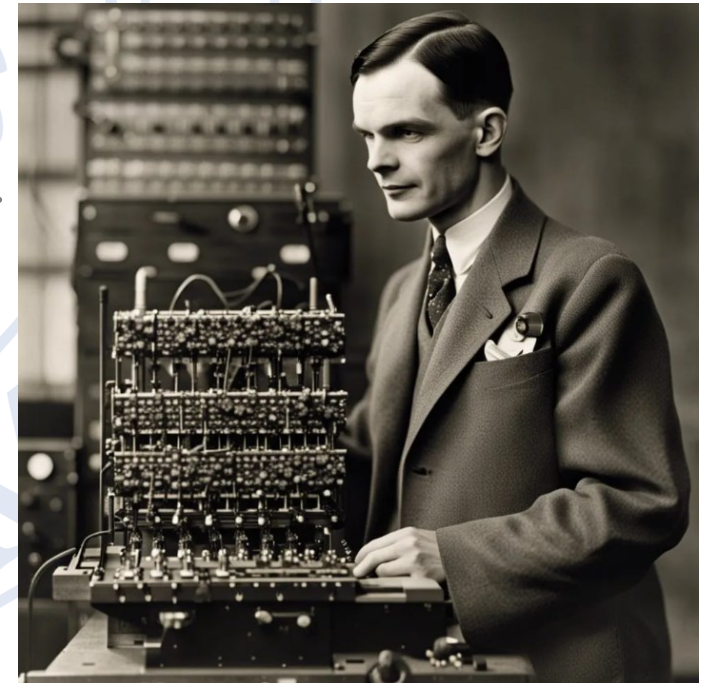


Alan Turing Y6
